## Tentative deal reached with Canadian Blood Services

OPSEU Locals 5101 and 210 have reached a tentative deal with Canadian Blood Services that successfully resolved all key issues negotiated at the table. The deal was reached after 16 days of negotiations and during our first day of conciliation. Your bargaining team is recommending that members accept the deal.

Ratification meetings are scheduled for Friday, November 7th in Toronto and Hamilton at the following locations.

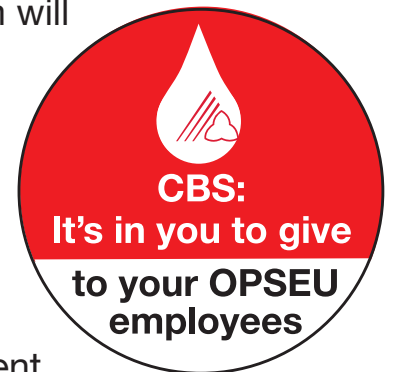
