Have your say on new OPSEU locals

January is the month for front-line LCBO employees to have their say on the make-up of their new OPSEU locals.

The Transition Committee set up to oversee the transition from OLBEU to OPSEU has proposed the creation of 27 brand new locals. The committee's proposal also assigns some LCBO employees in northern Ontario to 15 existing OPSEU locals.

Over 100 LCBO employees will meet Jan. 23-24 to discuss the plan, but members who do not attend the "local assembly" can still have their say. The plan, entitled "Your home in OPSEU," is in the mail now to all delegates to the local assembly, but it is also on the web at <http://www.opseu.org>.

Members can read the entire document online (complete with maps and key facts for each local) or download it and print it out. Members who are not coming to the assembly can send in their ideas for improvements to the plan. These comments will then be presented to the local assembly for consideration.
