Part-timers have rights too...

Stop the abuse!

When Casino Niagara was in the planning stages, the City of Niagara Falls was promised world-class facilities, community prosperity and most of all, stable, full-time jobs. At least, that's what was promised.

Instead, 46 per cent of the security work force at the casino is part-time. Poor hours, few benefits, more profit for the casino. And vacant full-time positions are left unfilled.

Your bargaining team is fighting to have all full-time positions filled so that part-time employees can move up to full-time work. For those working part-time, we want a fair system of scheduling that is based on seniority. It's right, and it's fair.

So far the employer hasn't agreed to our proposals on fair scheduling. They've tabled language to permit them to further abuse part-time employees. They want the ability to keep part-time employees past the end of their shift at straight time pay, instead of overtime pay.

For a business that is raking in millions, this type of abuse is petty and unacceptable. Tell the employer you want fair scheduling and overtime pay when you work past the end of your shift!
