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# Niagara's Casinos: They're only fun if you **DON'T** work there

**There is trouble brewing at Niagara's Casinos.**

A potential labour dispute between Security Officers and Casino management is looming, and despite the best efforts of the union, Falls Management Group does not seem interested in avoiding an all-out labour disruption.

**On June 2, 2006 at 12:01 a.m., security staff at both the Casino Niagara and Niagara Fallsview Casino are set to strike.**

Security staff are trying to negotiate a new collective agreement. While Falls Management Corporation draws in millions of dollars of revenue for the province, they refuse to fill full-time security positions and rely on part-time jobs. Job security and equity are the key issues.

If a strike occurs, security staff will be off the job. Any replacement workers that are brought in will not have the training to keep you safe. We recommend that you stay away from these casinos for your own safety and peace of mind.
