Kennedy House houses youth between the ages of 12 and 17 at the time of conviction for crimes such as:

- **Armed robberies**
- **Sexual assaults**

- **Murder**
- **Drug and weapons offences**
- **Escape from lawful custody**

Staff at Kennedy House are paid \$10,000 a year less than their equivalents at other Young Offender Facilities in the province and are forced to work with substandard security measures.
