Experience shows us we can't count on Ontario DHI to look out for our best interests.

In 2000, the Field Staff learned the hard way that the Employer's "interests" aren't the same as the front line staff.

What can you do?

It's time for everyone to join in the team in this round of bargaining. How? Support your team in every way you can.

We're back at the bargaining table on Sept. 19 & 20 and we need to know you're behind us. Wear your "United & Strong" button on the 19th & 20th.
