The Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan provides an important service to Ontario teachers. The members of the Elementary Teachers' Federation of Ontario value the work performed by the OTPP staff and believe they should receive compensation that fairly reflects their responsibilities and contribution to the success of the Teachers' Pension Plan.

It is unacceptable that the OTPP is using replacement staff to perform the work of its striking employees. As you may be aware, ETFO has refused to have any dealings with replacement staff during the present labour-management dispute.

On behalf of the Federation, I am urging the management negotiations committee to ensure there is a swift and fair settlement reached in the current contract negotiations with local 598 of the Ontario Public Services Employees Union. It is in everyone's interest that there be an end to the withdrawal of services on the part of the unionized staff.
