

Petition Campaign for Simcoe County Paramedics – Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Who can sign the petition?

We are asking all OPSEU paramedics, their families and friends and all members of the community sign the petition for Simcoe County paramedics. Petitioners must be residents of the Province of Ontario. Petitioners under the age of majority (19) can also sign the petition.

2. Can I create an electronic version of this petition?

No. According to the rules set out by the Legislative Assembly of Ontario, petitions must be written, typewritten or printed. Email, faxed or photocopied petitions are not admissible and will not be presented.

3. If I don't have enough space on the front side of the petition, can I use the backside of the form?

No. A petition must be written directly on the face of the petition, where the text of the petition is legible. Each petition holds 10 petitioners information. Please make more copies if you have more than 10 petitioners willing to sign.

4. Can I sign for a friend or family member?

No. The petition must contain original signatures only. Each person must print his or her name and address and sign his or her name under the text of the petition.

5. Who do I give the petition to if I am an OPSEU member?

For your convenience, please give your petition to your local president or steward, who will then be asked to forward it to Sabrina De Girolamo.
