Communication Is the Key

LHIN #2 – South West

- Ontario Labour Relations Board meeting scheduled for February 26th, in London.
- The LHIN announced it will increase “access to community health services”, investing “\$154,300 to assign case managers to hospital emergency department to assess and divert clients to more appropriate community services”.

LHIN #4—Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant

- OPSEU is arguing for all-employee bargaining unit. Other parties propose splitting the employees into more than one bargaining unit..
- The CCAC has announced restructuring which entails setting up “centres of excellence” with each centre located at one of the 5 branches.
- We’re now looking at a meeting at the Labour Board on March 26th.

LHIN # 9—Central East

- On February 16th, OPSEU was successful in getting all-party agreement on a separate bargaining unit for “all paramedical employees providing direct service...”. Our members keep their stand-alone unit, keep OPSEU as their union. Next? Bargaining a new contract!
- The OLRB process will continue with COPE, CUPE and ONA making submissions about bargaining units for the other employees.

LHIN #11 – Champlain

- The employer has told the OLRB that they do not support deferring the PSLRTA process until the “Kaymar” case is finished.
- A Labour Relations Officer will convene a meeting on February 28th.

LHIN #12—North Simcoe-Muskoka

- OPSEU has learned that the Ministry will announce that hospital-based CCACs will be included in the amalgamation. OPSEU staff are attending information meetings with the members to get details.

LHIN #13—North East

- OPSEU has amended its position at the OLRB to reflect what our members currently have.
- OPSEU has learned that the Ministry will announce that hospital-based CCACs will be included in the amalgamation. OPSEU staff are attending information meetings with the members to get details.
- OLRB meetings end of March.
