Vote Day is Coming!

As the bargaining agent for employees of the (former) MAHC, OPSEU has been entitled to participate at each stage of the PSLRTA process.

The Employer has been obligated to discuss everything, from the bargaining unit description to the times of the polls, with OPSEU. And we have involved our members in the process and the decisions.

While final details are still being worked out, we have been able to negotiate (or have had the Ontario Labour Relations Board order) arrangements for access to the affected employees.

We are inviting you to attend a 'drop-in' luncheon, so that we can answer all of your questions.

This is the first of several mailed info packages that you will receive. We will also be sending, via the employer's email system, several timely bulletins as required.

We are available by phone and email to any employee who would like to contact us confidentially.

You have a crucial decision to make. We believe that you should have as much detail as possible so that you can make an informed choice on vote day.

We will provide you with information about what happens after the vote, how OPSEU will represent and service you with this new

For those employees of the NSM CCAC who are presently non-union, you have not had a voice during the PSLRTA process. You have not had elected representatives looking after your interests and you have not had a say at the OLRB meetings.

It's not too late! On vote day, you will have the opportunity to choose representation for your future!
