OHA offer *unbalanced*

Our team went to the table looking for a balanced and fair wage increase. We asked for 25 per cent across the board over two years, and we asked for all classifications to be appropriately placed on a standardized wage grid. That's what we're asking for. After years of falling behind, that's what *all* of our members deserve.

But the OHA offered us an unbalanced wage increase designed to divide us.

Precious few professionals will be offered anything like what it takes to keep them on the job. The rest of us will be stuck in the low-wage ghetto we've been in for so long.

The OHA offered a measly 5.5 per cent by the end of a two year term

to 20 per cent of our group – the lowest paid in our group.

The other 80 per cent of our members would get a general wage raise of just 6.2 per cent, along with variable increases for specific professions at the OHAs discretion.

This is unacceptable!

Meanwhile, health science professionals in Saskatchewan just got 21.8 per cent (on average) after a strike.

Tell the OHA and the hospitals how you feel about this insult of an offer - give the team your commitment to do whatever it takes to get the best deal.

A fair wage for everyone!
