RTs and Nurses –Equal training –Same responsibility

The gap between RTs and RNs has continued to grow in the past decade. The OHA's offer failed to address this.

RTs have the same level of training, education, risk and responsibility. But their earnings have fallen 23 per cent behind those of nurses.

This gap started with the nursing shortages in the early '90s. The OHA admits shortages exist in our professions too, but

they refuse to pay us what we're worth.

The OHA is asking us to trust a job evaluation study. But even if this study shows we deserve as much as (or more than) nurses, would the OHA come up with the money?

Tell the OHA and the hospitals how you feel about this insult of an offer - give your team your commitment to do whatever it takes to get the best deal now!
