The OHA said our members below the RT pay level – that’s 20 per cent of our group – should get the same pay raise as clerks and cleaners got in the other central hospital contracts. This means 5.5 per cent over two years. It also says they should get the same vacation entitlement and refuses to equalize the vacation entitlement in our contract.

The OHA says that Pharmacy Technicians, EEG/ECG Technicians, Lab Assistants and others are the same as clerks and cleaners.

This just shows the kind of games the OHA likes to play.

They tried to divide our members and pit one union against the other.

Well these are dangerous games and we aren’t playing. (They can play with themselves.)

The truth is, the OHA tries to carve as close to the bone as possible. It thinks its offer might give just enough to those who might cause trouble, and peanuts to the rest.

We reject the double standard the OHA wants to create in our hospitals by shortchanging some of our members on pay and vacation time.
