## Task Force Recommendation #1: (i)

# Don't increase workloads

The very first recommendation of the Workload Task Force dealt with flexibility. Here's what the Task Force said:

1: (i) "The total workload of any participating teacher under a Modified Workload Arrangement should not exceed his or her workload in the preceding academic year".

"We consider that any concerns over a potential radical departure from the formula are met by recommendation 1:(i) and the concept of reasonability"

Here's the colleges' response to the very first item on a report **THEY** unanimously agreed to:

**"We will not implement this recommendation"**

This adds up to **increased workload** for some...and **job losses** for others
