We reached a tentative settlement shortly after 1 a.m. today. We'll be getting the details out to you very shortly.

All of you who wore black and/or buttons last Wednesday can take pride in your contribution to a fair new contract for CAAT Support.

Without a doubt the employer got the message and came to the table prepared to negotiate a decent settlement. Without your solid show of support, this would not have happened.

We will be setting up a ratification vote for later this month, and we will be asking that you ratify the agreement we have reached.

That vote has to be set up through the College Relations Commission, and you will understand that their office was closed last night when we reached the final agreement. We will keep you posted as soon as we have the date.

You can expect a package with full details of what is in the settlement.

We will probably issue a highlights bulletin later today, and follow that up with a more detailed report.
