The McGuinty government is planning to rush through legislation by early March, to implement what they're calling Local Health Integration Networks (LHINs.)

If passed this means service amalgamation and opening the door to competitive bidding for health services.

Fewer RNs, fewer MRI technologists, fewer pharmacy technicians, fewer RPNs, fewer cleaning staff, fewer

Competitive bidding means reduced wages, fewer benefits and no job security.
