The Liberal Party of Ontario is holding a fund-raising golf tournament at the **Club at Bond Head**.

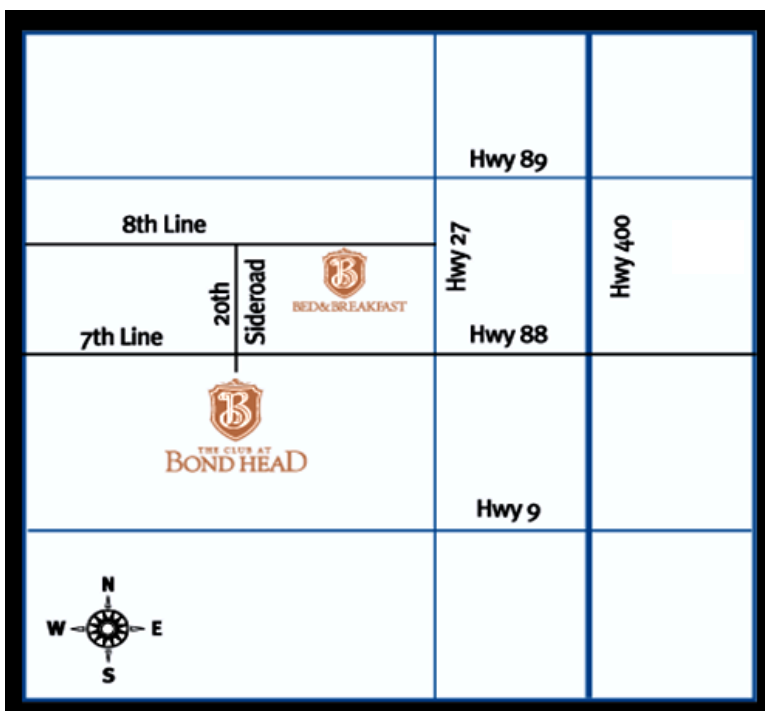
The party faithful and the corporate elite will pay **\$750 per person** to play golf and listen to a speech by Premier Dalton McGuinty.
