



Presentations

Fiona Crean, Assistant Deputy Minister, Organizational Effective Division presented an orientation on the Ministry Employee Census. Communications plan to be discussed at future MERC meeting.

Review/Sign off of Previous Minutes

1. November 28 and 29, 2007
2. February 12, 2008

Previous Business

1. Toronto South Detention Centre and South West Detention Centre – Union expressed concerns with the Ministry’s communication and presentation to staff without input and consultation with the Union. Assurances had been received from the Commissioner and ADM’s that the MERC and H&S would have meaningful input into the decision making with regards to design, programming, development of procedures and protocols, etc and this has not occurred. Union is concerned with content and language that pertains to the collective agreement.

Action: Management Co-Chair will discuss noted issues with Marg Welch, Executive Lead.

2. Correctional Officer Recruitment Policy – MOA was signed amending the terms and conditions of the MERC Agreements dated February 12, 2008, RPM Conversion and March 31, 2008, regarding non-CO Vacancies in Adult Institutions Division.

Action: Employer Co-Chair will send a copy of the MOA and the process to Superintendents.

3. Ontario Correctional Services College - Union provided a draft outline of the session's content to Employer Co-chair for review with the OCSC.

Action: Employer Co-Chair forwarded to OCSC for final review. Dan Sidsworth to contact Kathryn Biondi to further discuss.

4. Overtime Protocol Sub-Committee -- Provincial Overtime Protocol (POP) amended and signed.

Action: Management to review proposed revisions to Appendix C.

5. Training and Development Committee

Action: The Training and Development sub-committee held their first meeting at which time the Terms of Reference were discussed.

6. Unclassified Correctional Officer Sub-Committee

7. Staffing Strategy Probation and Parole - The Ministry did not commit to giving unclassified Probation and Parole Officers (PPOs) with full year and basic training interviews during future open competitions.

Bailiff department supervisors agreed in principle to form a sub-committee for a Health & Safety committee to speak directly to their issues. They also agreed to do Med Arbs for the grievance backlog. On a go forward basis, grievances will be addressed locally with the institutional grievances.

Action: Ministry Co-chair will follow up with HR to obtain clarification on "staffing reduction targets" and provide status update.

Action: The employer Co-Chair supports the removal of barriers to employment from the Ministry. Remove from agenda.

Standing Items

1. SAROC - Resumption of committee meetings. SAROC Steering Committee resumed meetings on May 14, 2008. Committee agreed that Vanier, Mimico, and a P&P cluster would be added to the current local SAROC Committees.
2. Labour Relations - Ministry regional labour relations forums taking place across the province. North Bay Joint LERC training a success. Positive changes taking place at the Toronto Jail.
3. HR Transformation Update – Transformation is ongoing. Next phase will take place on June 1.
4. Ministry Identification and Badges -- As of March 31/08, 5,349 badges have been shipped to institutions, community offices and other cost centres. Total badge expenditure has been \$55,227.35. Another 142 badges orders were filled in April 2008.
5. Interest Based Problem Solving training (IBPS) – Community Corrections is working on Interest Based Solving Problem training. Interest Based Solving Problem session held at the Kitchener Probation and Parole Office.
6. MCSCS / MCYS / MCSS - MOA – Employer is reviewing and costing out.

Action: Sandra to forward the November 2006 proposal.

7. Cross Ministry Laterals/Job Trades - Additional agreements have been reached relating to Job Trades and Lateral Transfers between the Ministries and OPSEU represented employees whose permanent positions are at specific institutions (Kenora Jail, Thunder Bay Correctional Centre, Hamilton-Wentworth Detention Centre, Ottawa Carleton Detention Centre, Sprucedale Youth Centre and Brookside Youth Centre).

Action: Remove from agenda.

8. Unclassified Straight Time Correctional Officer Hours and Number of Unclassifieds to be Provided Quarterly – Confirmed that it is currently being done.

New Business
